### **Reds by Glass**

**Lost Buoy** 2015 **\$12**  
**Shiraz** McLaren Vale, SA

This is an amazing blend of shiraz's taken from blocks around the vale area. This really is a superb drinking red, that denotes quality and simplicity while showcasing the elegant style of Lost Buoy Wines. Generously rich with an abundance of blueberry and dark cherry. Full bodied, rich, seamless layers of dark berries and long dusty tannins.

**Artuke** 2016 **\$13**  
**Tempranillo** Spain

Very deep red cherry color. Rich and muscular, with exotic roasted spice and blueberry preserve notes followed by racy graphite and espresso. The ripe finish of chocolate and spice is well-proportioned.

**Head in the Clouds** 2016 **\$11 GiGi**  
**Grenache/Graciano** Adelaide Hills, SA

Sultry Spanish steps dance lightly across a palate of lifted red fruit flavours, following gentle curves of voluptuous plum and exotic Asian spices. Let your tongue take a tango on the Wild Side.

**Hither and Yon** 2015 **\$11**  
**Cabernet Sauvignon** McLaren Vale, SA

Black fruits flowing throughout, chewy nougat, blackcurrant, chocolate, cloves, lightly spiced oak. Firm structure and grippy tannin, showing ageing potential. Medium bodied but has excellent concentration with Cabernet length and freshness.

# Reds by Bottle

**The Mysterious Mr Black**      2017      **\$75**  
Pareidolia **Sangiovese**      Barossa Valley, SA

Offering a perfume of red fruits, blackcurrants and spiced vanilla that pairs faithfully to the entanglement of strawberries, cherries and plums on the palate. Soft delicate tannins do a balanced waltz with the electrically colourful fruit.

**Head in the Clouds**      2016      **\$55**  
**Pinot Noir / Grenache**      Riverland, SA

In every way this gang of grapes gets together and lets loose; pummelling your eyes with its deep plum colour, peppering your nose with bitter-sweet mulberries and cramming your mouth with a creamy texture that belies its fruity finish.

**Vinteloper**      2016      **\$55**  
**Touriga Nacional**      Langhorne Creek, SA

Harvested relatively early the aim is a contemporary, complex flavoured yet medium bodied style. Restraint allows us to capture the alluring & distinct characteristics of the variety. It grabs your attention, immediately. Feels like the warmth you get from a cloudless, sun drenched winter afternoon.

# Whites by Glass and Bottle

**Karrawatta** 2016 **\$11 / \$50**

Anna's **Sauvignon Blanc** Adelaide Hills, SA

Passionfruit, cut grass, and snow pea, but toasty, smoky, spicy and textural too. Sauvignon Blanc grapes were harvested by hand, sorted and then whole bunch pressed. An additional four months in old French oak barrels build the wine's texture, complexity and softness.

**Adelina** Polish Hill 2015 **\$12 / \$55**

**Riesling** Clare Valley, SA

Invariably a tale of restraint versus generosity. Baby oil, vanilla, lemon/lime, tight acidity, fine chalk dust texture, a dunk of fresh lime in gin and tonic, good finish, though not quite leaping from cleft to cleft, as per the old gazelle.

**Adelina** Eternal Return 2016 **\$13 / \$60**

**Arneis** Adelaide Hills, SA

Arneis means "little rascal" in the Piedmontese dialect and this seriously savoury/earthy rendition of site and grape lives up to that name. With swathes of spicy, yellow plum and fuzzy peach fruit, and a chewy, phenolic-edged grip to finish off, there is nothing simple or sedate about this delicious wine. In spite of the extract-rich palate (given even more bass by 20 per cent indigenous fermentation in neutral oak) the wine remains zingy and super refreshing, encouraging you to have another glass, or three.



# Whites by Glass and Bottle

**Viognier**    Barossa Valley, SA

Fruit sourced from the heart of the Barossa Valley floor. It shows an extraordinary combination of perfume & body. Aromas of stewed apricots, citrus & vanilla bean that honors & follows through to the fruit forward palate. Textural with a poised line of acidity and great length.

## Sparkling

Good for all occasions. A fresh aroma of flowers and fruit immerses the taste buds from the very first glass. The dry but fruity tastes come across with a well-balanced hint of fresh citrus acidity in the finish, instantly enjoyable and easy-going.
