

## Part 2. Wines

### Reds by Glass

**Tscharke** 2014 **\$10**

**Shiraz** Barossa Valley, SA

The three Shiraz vineyards provide a complex, balanced wine that is layered with fruit. Rich aromas of dark chocolate, mulberries, clove and orange zest are evident. The restrained oak, dark fruits, chocolate, plum, savoury spice and chalky tannins provide a refreshing display of Shiraz flavours. This blend will continue to drink well until 2020.

**Bodegas Entre Suelos** 2012 **\$11**

**Tempranillo** Zamora, Spain

Very deep red cherry color. Rich and muscular, with exotic roasted spice and blueberry preserve notes followed by racy graphite and espresso. The ripe finish of chocolate and spice is well-proportioned

**Delinquente** 2016 **\$10**

**Montepulciano** Riverland, SA

Montepulciano isn't a common variety, and the Riverland ain't exactly the sexiest place to grow grapes. But boy does this Monte pack a punch! In every way this gang of grapes gets together and lets loose; pummelling your eyes with its deep plum colour, peppering your nose with bitter-sweet mulberries and cramming your mouth with a creamy texture that belies its fruity finish.

## Reds by Bottle

**Ochota Babarrels** 2016 **\$60**

**Isabella \* Fragola** Adelaide Hills, SA

Isabella is a very rare variety in Australia which is also known as Fragolla or Odessa. A few canes smuggled from Calabria in the late eighties were planted to make family wine for an Italian family that settled to the Piccadilly Valley Adelaide Hills in the 1950's. The aromatics in the wine are equally insane with quite estery characters ranging from frijolas, strawberries, tar, mentholime to Nordic forest berries, strudel and pain d'epice. The palate is compact, nervy and very vibrantly red...if you could taste the colour red... this is it.

**Vintelooper** 2015 **\$55**

**Touriga Nacional** Adelaide Hills, SA

Touriga Nacional is thought to have originated from the Dao region of Portugal and today is known as the preeminent variety of Portuguese red wine. It's perfectly suited to the climate & soil conditions of Langhorne Creek. Harvested relatively early the aim is a contemporary, complex flavoured yet medium bodied style. It grabs your attention, immediately.

**The Misterious Mr Black** 2013 **\$65**

**Grenache** Barossa Valley, SA

The bouquet leads with strong tar & gamey notes infused with an underlying scent of spice & red berries. Constantly evolving in the glass the gaminess slightly lifts its veil allowing the olfactory a sneak peak at the confectionary store available for the palate. An intensely juicy, fruit driven wine backed with elegant soft tannins & an incorruptible line of acidity that carries the fruit, giving great length.

## Whites by Glass and Bottle

**Mt Lofty Ranges Vineyard** 2014 **\$12 / \$55**

**Chardonnay** Adelaide Hills, SA

A picturesque sloping vineyard produces wines that are all hand pruned and grapes that are all handpicked. This chardonnay holds elegant and complex tones with a delicate balance. Spending ten months in French oak, it displays light citrus aromas combined with white stonefruit and a wonderful creamy, nutty & buttery multi layered finish.

**Vinteloper** 2015 **\$12 / \$55**

**Riesling** Clare Valley, SA

Layer upon layer of mineral, crunch, lime & florals, highlighted by the searing natural acidity reinforces the potential longevity of Riesling.

**Head in the Clouds** 2015 **\$11 / \$50**

**Pinot Grigio** Adelaide Hills, SA

The resulting wine shows its pure crystalline character in a mixed nose of lemon-lime blossom and honeydew melon. Fruit was hand-picked early to maintain the natural acidity, crushed and pressed with minimal skin contact and racked into old French barriques to complete fermentation.

## Whites by Glass and Bottle

**The Misterious Mr Black** 2014 **\$12 / \$55**

**Viognier** Barossa Valley, SA

Fruit sourced from the heart of the Barossa Valley floor. It shows an extraordinary combination of perfume & body. Aromas of stewed apricots, citrus & vanilla bean that honors & follows through to the fruit forward palate. Textural with a poised line of acidity and great length.

**Ochota Barrels** 2014 **\$13 / \$60**

**Gewurtztraminer** Adelaide Hills, SA

Lovely, rich talc fruit and sweet rose water fragrance, with tropicals too; a really bright and lively, pure and alluring wine, exotic. The palate is smooth and supple with fine, lively tang, great balance, finesse and power, and a sweet floral afterburn.

## Sparkling

**Martini** \$10 / \$45  
**Prosecco** Torino, Italy

Good for all occasions. A fresh aroma of flowers and fruit immerses the taste buds from the very first glass. The dry but fruity tastes come across with a well-balanced hint of fresh citrus acidity in the finish, instantly enjoyable and easy-going.

**Veuve Clicquot** \$135  
**Brut Yellow Label** France

A Champagne from the fuller-bodied school with flavours of buttered toast, brioche and biscuit to complement the ever present fine acidity and flavour length that is a trademark.

## Rosé

**Delinquente** 2013 \$10 / \$45  
**Nero D'Avola Rosato** Riverland, SA

Nero D'Avola, the famous black grape of Sicily, is just at home in the hot, dry climate of the Riverland as it is in the land of Don Corleone. Made in full bodied Rosato style, this Nero smells of sweet strawberries but is crisp, dry and luscious on the palate. Serve up over ice or straight from the fridge, and let the wine and the night take you in.
